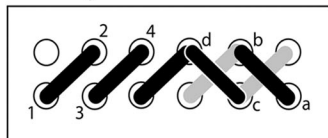

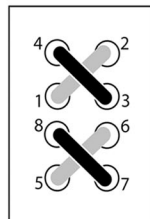
In this order, cross stitch & back stitch Max on 14 count Ecu perforated paper by Wichelt Imports. Using sharp pointed embroidery scissors, follow the cutting guides on the chart and cut it out. Finish it as an ornament or gift tag; make a key chain; decorate your backpack; wear it on a necklace; glue it to a large paper clip to make a bookmark; wear as a pin; turn it into a fridge magnet, etc...

General Stitching Instructions

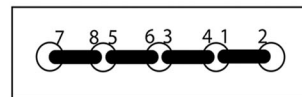
Horizontal Cross Stitch

When stitched on 14 count perforated paper or fabric, completed Max is approximately 1.5" x 4.25".

Back Stitch Key

Max:

DMC 310: (1 ply) All of the outlines and details

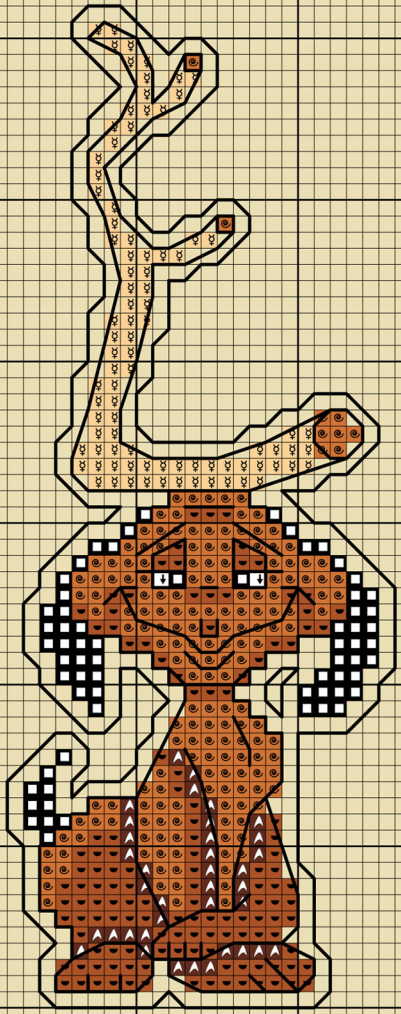
You will also need a small 6 ply segment of DMC 666 to make a tiny bow for the top of his head. Glue in place.

Use 3 plies floss to cross stitch on perforated paper
 Use 2 plies floss to cross stitch on most fabric

The lines around the motifs are cutting guides.
Do not back stitch these lines.
